Knox Cardiac Services caters for all aspects of cardiac care – medical, interventional and surgical. The Service comprises 10 coronary care beds and 28 cardiac monitored beds with provision for non-invasive and/or invasive haemodynamic monitoring and non-invasive ventilation at all 38 beds.

The unit is supported by a 24/7 Cardiac Catheterisation Laboratory performing up to 2000 cases per year, a 10-bed Intensive Care Unit, Cardiothoracic Surgery, a newly equipped Echocardiology Service and a newly refurbished Emergency Department.

On site Medical support is accessible 24 hour a day in both Intensive Care and the Emergency Department, with a well developed Medical Emergency Team support structure in place.
